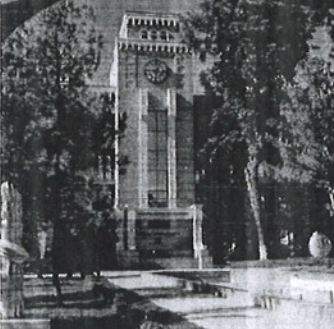

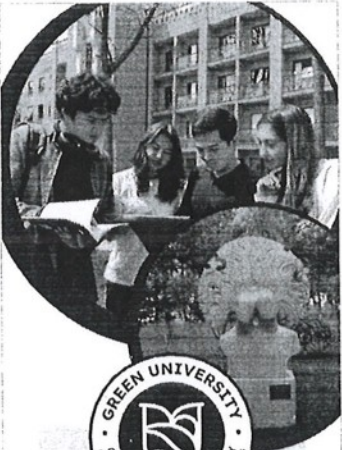

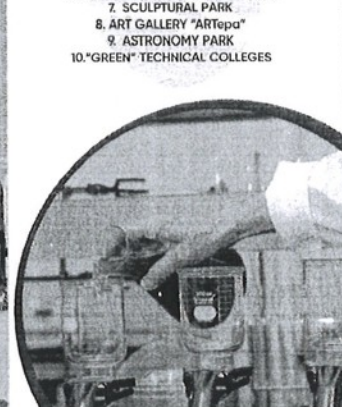

INFORMATION

on the Admission of International Students to the Bachelor's and Master's Degree Programmes of the Central Asian University of Environmental and Climate Change Studies (Green University) for the 2026/2027 Academic Year

Based on the requirements set forth in the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. **PQ-174** dated 31 May 2023 "On measures to organize the activities of the Central Asian University of Environmental and Climate Change Studies (Green University)" (hereinafter referred to as the "University"), as well as Decree No. **PQ-110** dated 25 March 2026 "On comprehensive measures to accelerate environmental education, science, and awareness-raising activities within the framework of the nationwide "Eco-Culture" project", **50 students** from Turkic states, will be admitted to the University on a grant basis in the following academic programmes:

Foreign citizens who have obtained a bachelor's degree or meet the requirements for master's degree programmes and who possess an English language proficiency certificate (upon request) or a recommendation letter from an official state institution of their country of citizenship are eligible to participate in the grant competition.

Candidates wishing to participate in the grant competition must submit electronic copies of the following documents to the University's official website **greenuniversity.uz** before the application deadline:

- A document confirming the candidate's identity (passport);

- A general secondary education certificate (diploma), bachelor's degree diploma, or master's degree diploma (for PhD applicants), translated into English and notarized;
- A 3x4 cm photograph;
- A student CV in English (including contact details and email address for further communication);
- English language proficiency certificate (IELTS – 5.5, CEFR – B2, TOEFL iBT – 72 points);
- A motivation essay written in English (250–300 words).

Evaluation Criteria for Foreign Applicants

The assessment of foreign candidates will be conducted based on the following criteria:

Maximum score – 100 points, including:

- Interview results – up to 70 points;
- Motivation essay – up to 30 points.

During the interview, candidates will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Knowledge and understanding relevant to the selected academic programme – up to 40 points;
- Logical thinking and ability to provide well-structured answers – up to 20 points;
- Professional motivation and clarity of goals – up to 10 points.

Motivation essays will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Language proficiency and quality of written expression – up to 5 points;
- Motivation for choosing the selected academic programme – up to 15 points;
- Logical reasoning and ability to present the topic effectively – up to 10 points.

The minimum passing score required for admission recommendation is 70 points.

For each foreign student awarded a grant, scholarship payments, airfare, accommodation, and living expenses will be covered in accordance with the established procedure based on an order issued by the Chairman of the National Committee for Ecology and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
